WALLPAPER PASTE



Availability: Five roll size

Usage:

- 1) Remove inner paste sachet from the tube
- 2) Pour 8 tubes (6 litres) of clean cold water into a bucket
- 3) Stir water and add powder slowly continuing to stir
- 4) Allow to stand for 3 minutes
- 5) Stir again. Your wallpaper paste is ready for use
- 6) Please refer to wallpaper hanging instructions enclosed with the wallpaper order

Storage: This product is water based and must be protected from frost and extreme temperature. Use within 6 months of purchase. We accept no responsibility for the deterioration of the contents and packaging after this date.

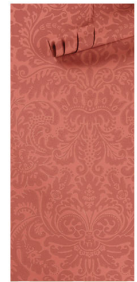
Disposal: Though water based, please do not dispose of into watercourse. Waste materials must be disposed of in accordance with the Environmental Protection Act 1990 and relevant regulations make there under. For further information contact your local Environmental Agency office.

Health & Safety: Ensure good ventilation during application and drying. In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. After contact with skin wash immediately with plenty of soap and water or a proprietary skin cleanser. Keep out of reach of children.

Soaking time: **IMPORTANT** Allow the paper to soak for approximately 5 minutes, until pliable.

To avoid shrinkage do not over paste, soak or stretch the paper.

All our papers are numbered and should be hung consecutively.
